

This Safeguarding for Governors course will give you the safeguarding knowledge you need to be confident in your role as a school governor and recognise your responsibilities for ensuring that your setting meets its safeguarding requirements.

By taking this course, you will gain knowledge of the law, guidance documents and policies that support effective safeguarding practice. You will learn how you can work with both your school's senior leadership and wider agencies within the safeguarding structure.

Module 1: Introduction to Safeguarding

This module explores the importance of effective safeguarding training and best practices, including the collaborative effort of multi-agency working, the roles and responsibilities of professionals involved in safeguarding and the legal framework that underpins these practices.

Module 4: Safeguarding Responsibilities of a School Governor

This module covers governors' responsibilities regarding safeguarding policies, acting as critical friends and providing oversight to ensure the school is fulfilling its legal duties. It also provides guidance on how to effectively prepare for Ofsted inspections and emphasises the importance of maintaining robust safeguarding systems for compliance.
